Event Report

The annual ASM BD Student Awards night was recently held at La Trobe University (Bundoora Campus; Tuesday February 23rd 2016). The evening was chaired by Dr. Karena Waller (The University of Melbourne and ASM VIC Branch Chair) and commenced with light refreshments before the presentation of fourteen undergraduate prizes for top achieving microbiology student studying at various Victorian Universities, including Monash University, RMIT University, La Trobe University (Bundoora and Bendigo campuses) and The University of Melbourne. Each of the undergraduate prizes consisted of a certificate, a cheque and a year's student membership to the ASM.

The evening then continued with six research presentations from postgraduate students (PhD or Masters by research) who presented the results of their research in the ASM BD Award category. The speakers, Emily Gulliver (Monash University), Georgina Pollock (The University of Melbourne), Joshua Newson (The University of Melbourne), Oonagh Bodin (La Trobe University), Lucie Semenec

(La Trobe University) and Tamsyn Stanborough (CSIRO Werribee/University of Tasmania) competed for a prize consisting of registration at the ASM Annual Meeting in Perth (July 2016), plus an airfare and \$300 towards the cost of attending. The winner of this prize was Joshua Newson (pictured below) who presented *"Identifying the host substrates of the SseK glycosyltransferase effectors from Salmonella".*

This year, because we did not have any applicants competing in the category for the Victorian ASM Branch Award (for Honours or Masters by coursework students), the VIC Branch committee decided to award this prize to the first runner-up in the above category. The prize, consisting of registration at the Annual Meeting in Perth (July 2016), plus \$200 towards the costs of attending was awarded to Georgina Pollock (pictured below) who presented "*Possible synergistic roles of the enteropathogenic Escherichia coli Type III effectors NIeB and NIeF*".

The evening concluded with supper and drinks prepared by Bread and Butta Catering. Overall, it was a great night for Microbiology! Over 60 people enjoyed the evening's activities.

Congratulations must be extended all students who competed for prizes on the night – their research presentations were excellent!
